1. Indian Air Force offers opportunities for **MALE INDIAN/ GORKHA (A SUBJECT OF NEPAL) CITIZENS** from **States of Assam, Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura, Meghalaya, Manipur, Mizoram, Nagaland, Chhattisgarh, West Bengal, Odisha and Jharkhand** to join the IAF as Airmen in the **Group 'Y', Medical Assistant** trade. The recruitment test will be held at 4 Airmen Selection Centre, Near Palta Gate, Air Force Station Barrackpore, Post- Bengal Enamel 24 Parganas (North), West Bengal- 743122 as per the selection programme given below:-

2. The recruitment test shall be conducted from 6 AM onwards as per the details given above. Only candidates fulfilling the domicile requirements (as mentioned at para 1) and eligibility conditions, reporting at 4 Airmen Selection Centre, Near Palta Gate, Air Force Station Barrackpore, Post- Bengal Enamel 24 Parganas (North), West Bengal- 743122 (rally venue) upto 10 AM (cut-off-time) on 27 August 2025, 30 August 2025 and 02 September 2025 shall be permitted to appear in the recruitment test.

Note. Candidates are to report at the designated rally venue on scheduled date/ time without fail. They have to cater for any contingencies including late running of trains while planning their move.

THE SELECTION TEST IS NOT FOR SELECTION AS COMMISSIONED OFFICERS/ PILOTS/ NAVIGATORS/ AGNIVEERVAYU

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

3. **Marital Status and Date of Birth Block.**

- 3.1. **Medical Assistant trade (For candidates with 10+2).** Candidate should be unmarried and born between 01 January 2005 and 01 January 2009 (both dates inclusive).
- 3.2. **Medical Assistant trade (For candidates with Diploma/ B.Sc in Pharmacy).** Unmarried candidate should be born between 01 January 2002 to 01 January 2007 (both dates inclusive). Married candidate should be born between 01 January 2002 and 01 January 2005 (both dates inclusive).

4. **Educational Qualification.**

- 4.1. Candidate should have passed **10+2/ Intermediate / Equivalent Examination** with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English from Education Boards recognised by Central, State and UT with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate and with 50% marks in English.

OR

Should have passed two years Vocational Course with non-vocational subjects ie. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English from Education Boards recognised by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

- 4.2. **Candidate with Diploma/ B.Sc in Pharmacy.** Candidate should have passed Intermediate/ 10+2/ Equivalent Examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English. In addition, Diploma/ B.Sc in Pharmacy with minimum 50% marks in aggregate with valid registration from State Pharmacy Council or Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) at the time of enrolment will be mandatory requirement.

Note-1. Education Boards (for 10+2 or equivalent) recognised by Central, State and UT shall only be permitted.

Note-2. Exact aggregate percentage of marks before decimal as written in the marks sheet of 10+2/ Intermediate/ Equivalent/ Diploma/ B.Sc in Pharmacy OR calculated as per the rules of concerned Education Board shall only be considered (For example 49.99% should be taken as 49% and not to be rounded off to 50%).

5. **Domicile Requirement.** To be eligible to appear in the recruitment rally at 4 Airmen Selection Centre, Near Palta Gate, Air Force Station Barrackpore, Post- Bengal Enamel 24 Parganas (North), West Bengal- 743122 the candidates shall be required to satisfy the following conditions:-

- 5.1. Permanent domicile of the districts of **States as mentioned at Para 1** shall produce the domicile certificate issued by any Gazetted Officer in Revenue Department or any other official authorised by the State Government of the particular State, prior to **commencement of examination**.
- 5.2. Sons of serving Air Force personnel [Officer/ Airmen/ NCs(E) and Unit cadre Civilians paid from Defence Estimates] whose father/ mother is presently serving in any Air Force unit/ any other organisation located in the districts of **States as mentioned at Para 1** irrespective of their domicile status, shall be permitted to appear in the rally subject to production of latest SOAFP (Son of Air Force Personnel) certificate (format available on www.airmenselection.cdac.in).
- 5.3. Sons of Air Force personnel [Officers/ Airmen/ NCs(E) and Unit Cadre Civilians paid from Defence Estimates] whose father/ mother is retired/ discharged/ deceased and they are residing in the districts of **States as mentioned at para 1** shall be permitted to appear in the rally subject to production of proof of minimum stay of one year along with original and photocopy of Service Book/ Discharge Book/ Casualty Service Certificate/ Service Particular Certificate (issued from DPO-3/ DAV, as applicable) in case of Officers/ Airmen/ NCs(E) and a Certificate duly signed by OIC Civil Admin and countersigned by CO/ C Adm O of the last served unit, in case of Civilians.

6. **Mandatory Medical Standards.** General Physical/ Medical Standards to become an Airmen are as follows:-

- 6.1. **Weight.** Weight should be Proportionate to height and age as applicable for IAF.
- 6.2. **Chest.** Minimum chest circumference should be 77 cm and chest expansion must be at least 05 cm.
- 6.3. **Hearing.** Candidate should have normal hearing ie, able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters by each ear separately.
- 6.4. **Dental.** Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points.

- 6.5. **General Health.** Candidate should be fit for the Air Force, must conform to the medical standards. Candidate should be of normal anatomy without loss or deformity of any appendages. He should be free from any active or latent, acute or chronic, medical or surgical disability or communicable disease, infection and skin ailments. Candidate shall be physically and mentally FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain.

- 6.6. **Gender.** Any candidate if found to have predominant characteristics of the opposite gender as evident on external physical examination, will be rejected as **Unfit**. Any candidate having undergone gender reassignment surgery will be declared **Unfit**.

- 6.7. **Height & Visual Standards.** Visual standards and minimum acceptable height for Medical Assistant and Medical Assistant (Pharmacist) for recruitment are as follows:-

Note-1. Candidates should bring latest prescription (not older than one month) and spectacles for corrected vision, if used. The prescription must bear the diopter measurement, name, signature, stamp and registration number of Ophthalmologist. Date of prescription should be within a month prior to appearing for medical examination.

Note-2. Candidates with history of LASIK/ PRK will not be accepted.

- 6.8. Details of medical standards are available on CASB web portal www.airmenselection.cdac.in.

7. **Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance (NDPS).** Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic substances banned under the NDPS Act 1985 shall be a reject criterion for selection into the Indian Air Force and airmen found either in possession or storing or distributing or consuming such drugs and substances after enrolment shall be liable for disciplinary action including dismissal from the Indian Air Force. ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY TO ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE IS FOLLOWED IN IAF.

8. **Body Tattoo.** Permanent body tattoos are not permitted. However, tattoos only on inner face of the fore arms (inside of elbow to the wrist), back (dorsal) part of the hand/ reverse side of palm and Tribals with tattoos which are as per custom and traditions of their tribes may be considered. Offensive, obscene, indecent, sexist or racist tattoos are prohibited regardless of location on the body. However, right to consider a tattoo acceptable or unacceptable will rest with the selection centre. Candidates with permanent body tattoos are to submit two postcard size photographs (close up and distant view) with details of size and type of the tattoo.

9. **Only Sikh candidates**, whose religion prohibits cutting of the hair or shaving of face, shall be permitted to grow hair and/ or retain beard and moustache. Accordingly, those Sikh candidates willing to retain the same as per laid down specification are to get their photographs with beard and moustache.

10. **Candidates discharged from Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ any other Government Organisation shall also be eligible subject to their discharge with NO ADVERSE ENTRIES.** Such candidate has to declare at the rally venue that he is an Ex-employee of above said organisations and produce original discharge certificate. In case of serving individuals, they must be in possession of NOC from their employer at the time of rally. If any candidate does not disclose the fact of being employed or that of being an Ex-employee, his candidature shall be cancelled at any stage during the selection process and if selected, shall be liable for discharge/ dismissal from the service for hiding the fact of his employment. **Candidates discharged from Indian Air Force for any reason are not eligible to appear in the rally. Candidates debarred permanently from any previous Air Force exam due to malpractices or any unfair activity are not eligible to appear in the rally. If found at a later stage, the candidature will be cancelled automatically.**

11. **Writing Material and Documents Required.** Candidates are to bring the following:-

- 11.1. HB pencil, eraser, sharpener, glue stick, stapler and black & blue ball point pen for writing.

- 11.2. 10 un-attested recent (not taken before six months) passport size colour photographs (front portrait in light background without head gear except for Sikhs). The photograph is to be taken with candidate holding a black slate in front of his chest with his name and date of photograph taken, clearly written on it with white chalk in capital letters.

- 11.3. Original and four self-attested photo copies of matriculation passing certificate (required for Date of Birth verification).

- 11.4. Original and four self-attested photocopies of 10+2/ Intermediate/ XII or equivalent/ vocational examination passing certificate and marks sheet.

- 11.5. Original and four self-attested photocopies of passing certificate and marks sheet of B.Sc/ Diploma in Pharmacy, if applicable.

- 11.6. Original and four self-attested photocopies of Domicile Certificate.

(or)

Original and four self-attested photocopies of duly filled Son of Air Force Personnel (SOAFP) Certificate for Sons of Serving Officer/ Airmen/ NCs (E) signed by competent authority.

(or)

Original and four self-attested photocopies of Service Book/ Discharge Book/ Casualty Service Certificate/ Service Particular certificate (issued from DPO-3/ DAV, as applicable) for sons of retired/ deceased/ discharged Officer/ Airmen/ NCs (E) and proof of minimum stay of one year.

(or)

Original and four self-attested photocopies of Certificate duly filled for sons of serving Air Force Civilian employees signed by OIC Civil Admin and countersigned by CO/ C Adm O of the last served unit.

(or)

Original and four self-attested photocopies of Certificate duly filled for sons of retired/ deceased Air Force Civilian Employees signed by OIC Civil Admin and countersigned by CO/ C Adm O of the last served unit and proof of minimum stay of one year.

- 11.7. NOC in original and four self-attested photocopies from the employer for candidates presently serving in any government organisation (if applicable).

- 11.8. **Candidates discharged from Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Any other Government Organisation.** Original and four self-attested photocopies of Discharge Certificate (as issued from Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Government Organisation).

- 11.9. Original and four self-attested photocopies of NCC 'A', 'B' or 'C' Certificate (if applicable).

BEWARE: IMPERSONATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED

Note-1. Under no circumstances the candidates shall be permitted to appear in the rally without original educational marks sheets/ passing certificates & documents mentioned above in paragraph 11. However, candidates with photocopies of educational marks sheets/ passing certificates may be permitted to appear in the rally only on production of a certificate from College/ Institution Principal certifying that original educational certificates/ marks sheets are deposited with College/ Institution. In exceptional circumstances, digilocker verified certificates will be accepted and candidates will be issued with CSV (Certificate Subject to Verification) status. Candidates are thereafter required to submit original certificates to nearest ASC within one month from date of issue of CSV, to clear the CSV status.

Note-2. Internet copy of marks sheet is not acceptable.

Note-3. The printout of educational certificates obtained from mobile snapshot/ photo image will not be accepted. Candidates are to bring legible photocopies of educational certificates for verification.

11.10. Body tattoo photographs as per para 8 above.

11.11. **Consent Form for PFT and Medical tests.** Candidates shall bring the "Consent Form" (as per the format given below) to the rally venue and submit it before conducting of the PFT. Format for consent form is also available in www.airmenselection.cdac.in.

Note. Candidates below 18 years of age are to get the consent form signed by their parent/ guardian. However, candidates above 18 years of age can sign the consent form themselves.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

12. **Tenure & Training.** Enrolment shall be for an initial period of 20 years (subject to service conditions) which may be extended up to the age of 57 years (subject to service conditions). Initially, candidates shall be sent for a Joint Basic Phase Training (JBPT) at designated Basic Training Institute. On successful completion of JBPT, candidates will be sent for trade training of specific duration which shall include security training or any other training as per service requirements. Training is however liable to be terminated at any time if the trainee fails to achieve the required standards in academics, profession, physical fitness and discipline or is found to be medically unfit. AFTER SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF ALL STAGES OF TRAINING, THE AIRMEN SHALL BE DEPLOYED ON JOBS AS PER INDAIN AIR FORCE REQUIREMENT. TRADE ALLOTTED SHALL NOT BE CHANGED ON CANDIDATE'S REQUEST ON ANY GROUNDS.

Note-1. Candidates will not be permitted to stay with their family during the training period.

Note-2. Unmarried candidates will not be permitted to get married till successful completion of their ab-initio training.

13. **Employability.** Airmen enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest at the discretion of the Indian Air Force.

14. **Pay & Allowances.** During training, a stipend of ₹14,600/- per month shall be paid. On completion of training the starting gross emoluments at the minimum of scale of pay including Military Service Pay (MSP) is ₹26,900/- per month. In addition, dearness allowance (as applicable) which, in subsequent years, may rise as per the career progression of the individual.

15. Other allowances such as Transport Allowance, Composite Personal Maintenance Allowance (CPMA), Leave Ration Allowance (LRA), Children Education Allowance, HRA etc. shall also be admissible to Airmen, as per relevant government instructions.

16. **Higher Education.** Airmen shall be permitted to pursue higher education qualification only after acquiring prescribed skill grade in their trade and prescribed years of service as stated in HRP.

17. **Perks.** Perks such as ration, clothing, medical facilities, accommodation, CSD facilities, Leave (60 days annual and 30 days casual in a calendar year as a privilege, subject to service exigencies), Recreational facilities, transport for school going children and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) shall also be provided as per the existing rules. Group Insurance Cover of ₹62.5 Lakhs at a premium of ₹3200/- per month for all Airmen and facility of Group Housing Scheme are also extended.

18. **Job Specification of Medical Assistant Trade.** As a Medical Assistant, you are to be trained in nursing and first-aid. You will also be involved in management of medical stores, dispensaries and ward supervision and other Air Force duties.

Note. Airmen shall also have to undertake any other tasks as assigned by superior authorities.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

19. **Verification of Eligibility.** Original educational certificates (10th passing certificate, 12th passing certificate & mark sheet and original degree/ Diploma certificate & mark sheets of B.Sc/ Diploma in Pharmacy) and other required applicable original documents like NCC 'A', 'B' or 'C' certificate, Son of serving Air Force Personnel (SOAFP) certificate (or), Discharge Book, Service Book, Service Particular Certificate/ Casualty Service Certificate (or) Discharge Certificate (if discharged from Army/ Navy/ Government organisation), Consent form, passport size colour photographs and domicile proof (as per Para 5 above) shall be required and scrutinized/ verified at the examination venue prior to commencement of PFT to ascertain the prima-facie eligibility. Detailed verification will be carried out later in respect of candidates who pass written Test and AT-I. Those candidates who do not meet the laid down educational criteria shall be rejected during initial verification of original certificates & mark sheets prior to conduct of PFT and also during detailed verification on clearing the PFT as well as written test or if found ineligible at any subsequent stage.

Note-1. In the case of SOAFP, the name of the candidate, parent's name and the date of birth of the candidate as mentioned in the discharge book/ service book/ service particular certificate/ casualty certificate (as applicable) must be the same as mentioned in the matriculation passing certificate of the candidate.

Note-2. The original passing certificates/ marks sheets will not be retained by the selection centre. The same will be returned to the candidates on completion of detailed verification.

SEQUENCE OF EXAMINATION

MOBILE PHONES/ SMART WATCHES/ ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE PROHIBITED IN TESTING AREAS. CANDIDATES FOUND IN POSSESSION OF MOBILE PHONES/ ELECTRONIC DEVICES SHALL BE DEBARRED PERMANENTLY

20. **Physical Fitness Test.** PFT consists of two parts ie, PFT-I and PFT-II.

PFT- I. Candidates have to complete 1.6 Kms run as per the following timings to qualify PFT-I:-

Test	Maximum permissible time	
	For candidates up to the age of 21 years	For candidates above 21 years of age and holding Diploma/ B.Sc in Pharmacy
1.6 Km run	Within seven minutes	Within seven minutes 30 seconds

PFT- II. Candidates who qualify PFT-I to undergo PFT-II after 10 minutes of recuperation time. The sequence of exercises and maximum time period are as follows:-

Test	Max Time Period	Remarks
10 Push-ups	One minute	Test will be conducted after 10 minutes break on completion of run
10 Sit-ups	One minute	Test will be conducted after two minutes break on completion of 10 Push-ups
20 Squats	One minute	Test will be conducted after two minutes break on completion of 10 Sit-ups

Note. Candidates are advised to bring their sports shoes and shorts/ track pants. Detailed procedure on expected technique for Push-ups, Sit-ups and Squats is available on CASB Web Portal www.airmenselection.cdac.in .

21. **Written Test.** All candidates who qualify PFT shall undertake written test on the same day. The written test will be objective type and question paper shall be bilingual (English & Hindi) except for English paper. Answers are to be annotated on OMR sheet. Detailed procedure shall be explained before conduct of the examination. Duration of the written test will be 45 minutes and shall comprise of English (20 questions) as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA) (30 questions). CANDIDATES ARE TO QUALIFY IN EACH PAPER SEPARATELY. Results of the written test shall be declared on the same day.

Marking Pattern for Written Test (Objective).

- 21.1. One mark for every correct answer.
21.2. Nil (0) marks for un-attempted question.
21.3. 0.25 marks shall be deducted for each wrong answer or choosing more than one option as answer.

Note. The question paper is a confidential document of Indian Air Force. All candidates are to note and understand that access to the question paper is permitted only during the examination. Question paper in any form whatsoever will not be provided to the candidate after examination.

22. **Adaptability Test- I (AT-I).** All candidates who pass the written test shall undertake AT-I (objective type written test) which is to assess suitability of a candidate for employment in the Indian Air Force which involves deployment in varied geographic terrain, weather and operational conditions.

23. **Adaptability Test-II (AT-II).** All candidates who pass the AT-I shall undertake AT-II on the same or subsequent day depending on the local conditions. AT-II is to select candidates who can adapt to the environment of Indian Air Force and are able to adjust to the military way of life.

24. **Medical Examination.** Candidates who qualify Adaptability Test-II shall be medically examined in the month of September 2025 at SMC, Air Force Station Barrackpore. Medical examination shall be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards in IAF Publications and policy in vogue on subject issue. Medical examination would also include Baseline Investigations of:-

24.1. Blood Haemogram - Hb, TLC, DLC, Platelets.

24.2. Urine RE/ ME.

24.3. Biochemistry:-

24.3.1. Blood Sugar Fasting/ Post Prandial.

24.3.2. Serum Cholesterol.

24.3.3. RFT- Serum Urea, Uric Acid, Creatinine.

24.3.4. LFT- Serum Bilurubin, SGOT/ SGPT.

24.4. Radiograph Chest (PA view).

24.5. ECG (R).

24.6. Any other investigation deemed necessary by the Recruiting Medical Officer.

25. Candidates declared medically unfit can avail the option for 'Appeal Medical Board' (AMB) against their unfitness by depositing ₹40/- in a Government Treasury/ RBI/ SBI through Electronic Military Receivable Order (e-MRO)/ Military Receivable Order (MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of e-MRO/ MRO, photocopy of Unfitness Certificate to be submitted to the representative of 4 ASC Barrackpore within three working days of medical examination. AMB centre will be SMC, Air Force Station Bagdogra.

26. The Recruitment Medical Officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate Fit or Unfit during Initial Medical Examination, Appeal Medical Board and Medical Examination prior to Enrolment.

27. The candidates shall be governed by Armed Forces Medical standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or review after the Appeal Medical Board.

Note-1. Candidates are advised to get tartar and stains removed from their teeth before appearing for the medical examination. Ears should be free of wax. Candidates should be prepared to stay for the medical examination for four to five days under their own arrangement. No TA/ DA shall be admissible.

Note-2. Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Air Force.

Note-3. Request for change of Medical Examination Centre or Date of Medical Examination shall not be entertained.

GENERAL

28. General Instructions for candidates are as follows:-

28.1. The candidates should carry their AADHAAR Card as proof of identity whenever they report for the selection test and Medical Test.
